Council Process: Everyone who lives, works or owns property within the boundaries of the Panorama City Neighborhood Council is a "stakeholder". All stakeholders are members of the Council. Stakeholders elect a Board of Directors to represent them. This Board is recognized as the decision-making entity by the City of Los Angeles. The current Board of Directors was elected in an independently administered election on September 8, 2007. While the Board is the official decision-making entity, meetings are conducted as much as possible in a town hall spirit. Committees are open to anyone with an interest in Panorama City. Panorama City's Neighborhood Council is much more than its Board, and it depends on public participation for its success.
