Woodman Avenue Median Project



The Woodman Avenue median between Lanark and Saticoy will be the site of a multi-million dollar project to recharge the groundwater from storm water. The project will also beautify the 3500-foot median with native plants, including Sycamore trees. A substantial portion of the cost will be funded by a state grant.

Removal of the asphalt and Magnolia trees will begin on or about March 1 2012. Work on the new median will begin in April. The Panorama City Neighborhood Council has arranged a public meeting about the project on Wednesday evening, February 29, at 6:30 pm, in the Kaiser Permanente Campus South 1 Building.
